

The cost of the work

The total cost of all the work necessary to preserve St. Margaret's will be in excess of £500,000. In 2006 we set up the Friends of St. Margaret's, a registered charity, to raise money for the restoration. At present, we have around £58,000 and are awaiting the outcome of a grant application to English Heritage but, even if this is successful, we will still need to raise funds to save the church for future generations.

We believe that St. Margaret's is so much a part of our local and national heritage that it deserves support from the wider community, and so we hope that you will feel able to help the project in any way you can.

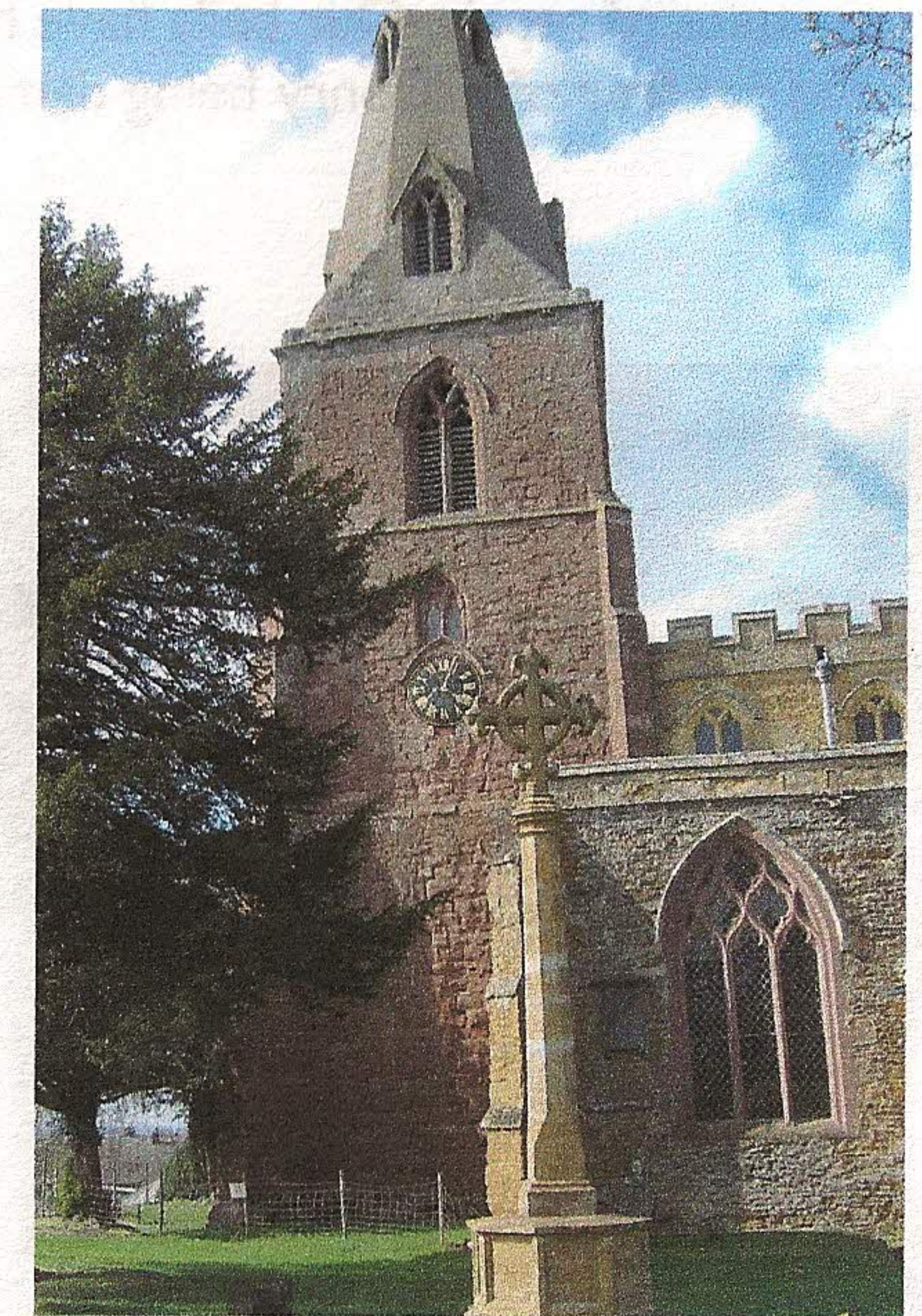
