

Minutes of a meeting of the Friends of St. Margaret's

Treasurer's Report: Ann reported that she was holding £297.19 in petty cash, the deposit account held £11,589.74 and the current account, £37,884.24.

Curry Night, Friday, January 19: Cooks and dishes were agreed, setting-up to be at 5pm as usual.

Kitchen update: We had finally received the architect's outline plans and these were studied. They had been listed as an agenda item for the Diocesan Advisory Committee's next meeting later in January. Subject to the DAC's approval, detailed plans would then be drawn up and a faculty applied for.

Roof repairs: The contractor was severely behind schedule, mainly because the scaffolder had been delayed by problems with a previous job. It was not yet possible to give a fixed date for our work to start.

Bilton Silver Band: The date fixed for the concert, Saturday, May 19, unfortunately now clashed with not only the Royal Wedding but also, the FA Cup Final, which did not kick off until, probably, 5pm. It was agreed that we should try to re-arrange the concert date. Ann agreed to contact Margaret Dorman-Frost's daughter, who was dealing with the booking.
