

Minutes of a meeting of the Friends of St. Margaret's

Treasurer's Report: Ann reported that she was holding £776.82 in petty cash, the deposit account held £11,720.93 and the current account, £38,368.65.

Sue had reclaimed £1,189 VAT on the clock winding conversion, reducing the final bill to £5,943. We were also awaiting payment of £170.59 in respect of the architect's initial fees in relation to the servery.

Curry and Casserole Night, January 17: All the arrangements and dishes were settled, with a 5pm meet as usual to set up.

New Servery: There was no further news regarding a starting date.

Any Other Business: Sue suggested that, for their concert on May 16, 8 days after the 75th anniversary of VE Day, Bilton Silver Band could be asked to give it a 'Last Night of the Proms' or suitably patriotic theme. With unanimous agreement, she would contact the band.
