

Minutes of a meeting of the Friends of St. Margaret's

Treasurer's Report: Ann reported that she was holding £334.47 in petty cash, the deposit account held £11,635.77 and the current account, £38,140.75. We had had £205 back from the Northants Historic Churches Trust, representing our half-share of sponsorship money.
